



Membership of Shettleston Housing Association

Rights and Responsibilities

INTRODUCTION

The Association operates a rule book which outlines the nature of membership, its rights and responsibilities. Full details of the Rules will be forwarded to you on acceptance of your membership application.

This information sheet is a summary of aspects of the Association's Rules and should not be regarded as superseding them. If you are in any doubt as to the details contained in this summary you should contact the Association and arrange for a copy of the current Rules to be provided to you.

RIGHTS

As a member you are entitled to:

- Attend and participate in the Association's Annual General Meeting and any Special General Meetings that are called.
- Vote at all such General Meetings.
- If duly nominated, stand for election to the Management Committee.
- Call a Special General Meeting, where such a request is made by at least 20% of the Association's members.

RESPONSIBILITIES

The following conditions apply to membership of the Association:

- If you are not a tenant of the Association you should notify the Association if you change your address. Should you fail to do so your membership will be cancelled.
- Your membership will be ended if you do not attend or submit apologies for five Annual General Meetings.
- Your membership may be cancelled by the Association if your conduct is such that it leads to a complaint and it is the view of the General meeting that this conduct is not in the interests of the Association. Ending your membership would require a two thirds vote at such a meeting.
